

- (3) When breast cancer is about to manifest, all the energy in the body goes to that one area.





04 VEDIC MATH SPIRITUAL SUTRAS OF INDIA

Vedic math is a very short way of doing lengthy math problems in one step.

It originated from the spiritual sutras of India where the father of Vedic math, Shri Bharathi Krishna, discovered that the sutra laws also translate into mathematical formulas.

Here is a short cut for multiplying: **4,523 x 11**:

- (1) First insert zeros on each end of the given number: **045230**
- (2) Then add from right to left the numbers like this: 0+3=3, 3+2=5, 2+5=7, 5+4=9, 4+0=4
- (3) Therefore, (starting backwards, writing the numbers) **4,623 x 11** = **49,753**.
- (4) If any number adds to more than 9 when adding the numbers, carry 1.

10 JUST THE FRACTIONS


